in accordance with the following guidelines:

The "Revista Internacional & Comparada de Derechos Humanos" (ISSN: 2992-8613), is a biannual academic and scientific edition of the Academia Interamericana de Derechos Humanos focused on the dissemination of analytical, critical, contextual and theoretical studies of human rights in national and international perspectives.

Guiding theme of the called number:

Texts related to human rights in general may be submitted for consideration for publication. However, the guiding theme of this edition will be **"The bicentennial of the Constitution of 1824"**. Some suggested topics for contributions are:

1. Analysis of the background and the political, social and cultural context in which the Constitution of 1824 and the Constitutive Act of the Mexican Federation were conceived.
2. The processes of discussion and approval of the Constitutive Act of the Mexican Federation and the Constitution of 1824.
3. Innovation and conservatism in human rights in the Constitution of 1824.
4. Validity of the postulates established in the Constitution of 1824 at present.
5. Contributions by notable actors such as Miguel Ramos Arizpe, Valentín Gómez Farías and Carlos María de Bustamante, among others, to the integration of the Constitution of 1824 and/or the issuance of the norms that made it operational.
6. Comparative analysis of the Constitution of 1824 with other constitutions of its time.
7. The political and legal debate in the years following the promulgation of the Constitution of 1824.
8. The bicentennial of the founding of the State of Coahuila and Texas.

Types of collaborations admitted:

a) Doctrinal articles. Academically consistent texts on the priority and specific topics of the publication and whose focus is the study of human rights in national, international and comparative perspective. In order to decide on their publication, the texts received are submitted to a double-blind peer review system. Approximate length 7,000 to 15,000 words.

b) Essays. Texts that analyze, reflect, interpret and evaluate different topics immersed in the national, international and comparative study of human rights through the essay genre. Approximate length 4,000 to 7,500 words.

c) Normative and jurisprudential commentaries. Texts in which the normative and judicial pronouncements that observe relevant or novel criteria related to human rights from a national, international and comparative perspective are analyzed. Approximate length 2,500 to 3,500 words.

d) Notes. Texts that reflect and analyze relevant contemporary issues related to human rights in national, international and comparative perspective. Approximate length 1,500 to 2,000 words.

e) Bibliographic reviews. Summaries that report on the content, contribution and significance of academically relevant legal works on human rights published in recent years, or previously published and considered essential in the topics addressed by the issue. Approximate length 500 to 1,500 words.

Language of the collaborations:

Spanish or English.

Date of publication of the call:

July 02, 2024.

Deadline for sending contributions:

October 15, 2024.

Date of publication of the convened issue:

December 01, 2024.

Formal indications:

Contributions must comply with the following requirements:

1. The citation format should be strictly followed according to the editorial guidelines of the Academia IDH available at:
www.academiaidh.org.mx/lineamientoseditoriales
2. Contributions should be sent to the journal's e-mail address:
revista.icdh@academiaidh.org.mx together with the "Declarations" form (available at <https://www.academiaidh.org.mx/revista-icdh>) signed and in PDF format.
3. The collaboration file must be in Open Office, Microsoft Word format.
4. In the case of doctrinal articles, the title, abstract and key words in English and Spanish should be indicated.
5. In cases where the contribution contains tables or diagrams, these must be inserted with the text and not as an image file.
6. When sending the contributions, the subject of the e-mail should be "Collaboration volume VII number II".
7. The collaboration file sent should not contain data or metadata that would allow identification of the author. The author's name and orcid number should only be specified in the text of the e-mail.
8. The content of the proposed publication must be unpublished.
