Akademía. International and Comparative Magazine of Human Rights is a half-yearly magazine of academic and scientific nature of Academia Interamericana de Derechos Humanos which publishes analytic, critical, contextual, and theoretical studies in an international and comparative perspective of human rights in a national, international, and comparative context.

Subject of the convened edition:

Human rights with a gender perspective.

Content of the issue:

The convened issue intends to gather works of investigation oriented to the analysis of human rights from a gender perspective, focused on two vulnerable groups: women and the $L_{GB\Pi\Pi\Pi}Q+$ community. In the current edition, we will address human rights in a cross-cutting manner, on the basis of gender perspective.

Suggested topics for the collaborations:

- 1. Discrimination and violence against women and the LGBTTTIQ+ community.
- 2. Human rights and the feminist currents.
- 3. International standards of human rights with a gender perspective.
- 4. Current context of human rights for women and the LGBTTTIQ+ community in the Covid-19 pandemic, impact differentiated by gender.
- 5. LGBTTTIQ+ community rights; genesis, debate, and implementation.



Types of admitted works:

Articles and reviews of published works that have relation to the subject of the convened edition and the suggested topics.

The articles are subjected to a double-blind peer review process.

Languages for the collaborations:

Spanish or English.

Length required:

Reviews: 500 to 1,500 words.

Notes: 1,500 to 2,000 words.

Commentaries: 2,500 to 3,500 words.

Articles: 7,000 to 15,000 words.

Deadline for the publication of the call for participation:

March 1st, 2022.

Deadline for delivery of the collaborations:

May 31st, 2022.

Publication of the convened edition:

October 21st, 2022.

Formal instructions:

The collaborations will have to meet the following requirements:

- A quotation format in accordance with the editorial guidelines of the Interamerican Academy of Human Rights will be strictly followed, available on: www.academiaidh.org.mx/lineamientoseditoriales.
- 2. The collaborations must be sent to the magazine's e-mail address: revista.akademia@academiaidh.org.mx along with the format "Declaraciones" (available on www.academiaidh.com/revista-akademia), duly signed and on PDF file format.
- 3. The file of the collaboration sent is in Open Office, Microsoft Word, or PDF format.



- 4. In case the collaboration contains tables or diagrams, these must be included by text and not as an image file.
- 5. When collaborations are sent, the e-mail subject line must be "Collaboration Akademía volume V number II".
- 6. The file of the collaboration that is sent must not contain data or meta-data that may lead to identify the author. The name of the author must only be specified within the text of the e-mail.
- 7. The content of the proposed publication must be original.
